Our Services

For individuals and families in need of treatment for life's emotional problems, Mulberry Center (Mulberry) is here to provide professional and confidential services in an outpatient setting. Mulberry offers individual, marital and family counseling, including medication management, when clinically indicated. The focus of our therapy sessions include problems associated with:

- Marriage
- Family Conflicts
- Anxiety and Depression
- Alcohol and Drug Abuse
- Child and Adolescent Behaviors
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorders
- Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
- Anger

With the first appointment, an assessment is completed by one of our licensed therapists in order to help us specifically identify the patient's personal issues. From the assessment, a treatment plan is developed (with the patient's input) that begins the process of establishing a course of therapy sessions.

Specialized Treatment

Mulberry provides treatment for individuals with alcohol/drug issues through individual, group and family therapy. In addition, specialized addiction services, which allow for safe detoxification on an outpatient basis, are available for select patients involving management of appropriate medication along with individual, family or group therapy.

The primary objective is to set the course for patients to move toward a life free of alcohol and drug use. Each treatment plan varies in intensity and structure, depending on the level of abuse/dependency, and includes an education component which encourages use of a 12-step recovery model.

Employee Assistance Program

Mulberry is a Employee Assistance Program (EAP) provider for several local companies employees and eligible dependents. EAP benefits demonstrate the employer's recognition that employees are valuable assets to the company, and, with the availability of EAP services, employees and their eligible dependents can seek help when it is needed.

The cost of services for a select number of sessions is paid by the employer. Our EAP arrangements with employers assures privacy and confidentiality.
